* Three mandatory orientation days will require students to stay on campus until 4:30 p.m. in September 2017

Prerequisites: High school graduate (or GED equivalent) and a baccalaureate degree; higher degree strongly preferred. Two years active membership in good standing with a faith community. Exceptions to these requirements will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
